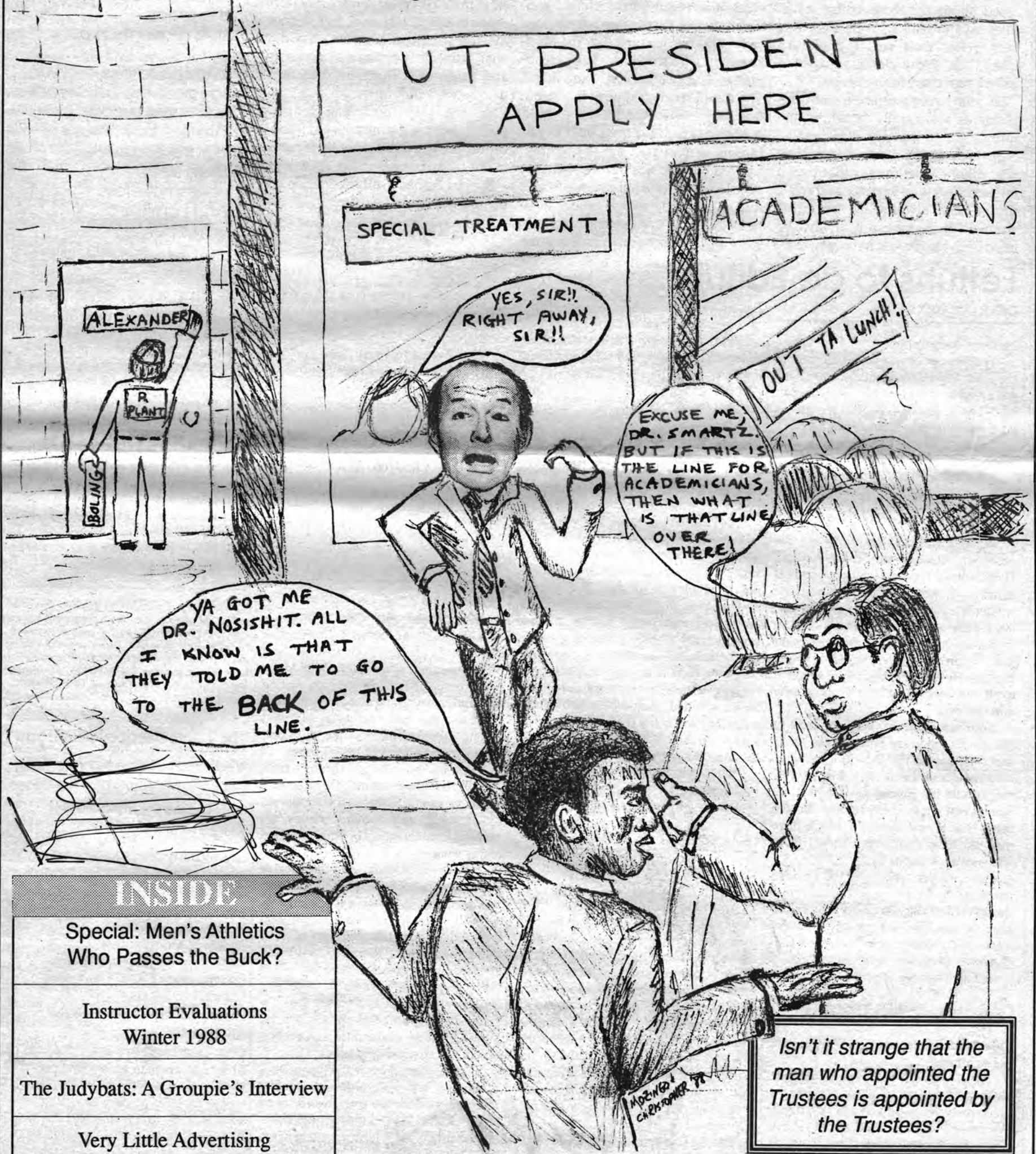

To the Beacon editor:

[It was mailed to us—Eds.]

This letter is addresses to Christopher Gray, Lance Bledsoe, Bob Daedalus, and other publishers of the Lame Duck Manifesto instructor evaluations. I am writing as a graduate teaching associate, although not one who has ever been included among these evaluations. So my comments do not represent "sour grapes."

I don't dispute the publication's right to publish evaluations of UTK professors and instructor's. Since we are supported by taxpayers' and students' money, we may legitimately expect public evaluation of our work.

It is, however, unfair and unethical to publish damaging comments about professors based on only one student's response. Of the 600 courses the Manifesto reported on, more than 350 were rated by a single student. Of these 350 student responses, more than 150 reported a 2.00 rating (negative) or lower.

These 156 students could be disgruntled, lazy flunkouts, for all anybody knows, and their evaluations only a reflection of their own sour grapes.

In the future, I hope the Lame Duck Manifesto will only report on courses receiving evaluations from two or more students. This is still a far cry from statistical accuracy, but at least professor's feelings and reputations won't be as unfairly

damaged. And students will get more accurate evaluations of these courses.

### How To Use This Information:

1. The first number next to the Instructor's name is the total number of responses we had regarding that prof. Remember, the fewer people surveyed, the more unreliable his/her evaluation.
2. The next number is the Grade Point Average of the Instructor. The Instructors were graded on a scale of A-F, where 'A' is 4 and 'F' is 0. The total number of these 'quality points' is divided by the total number of responses, much like the way your own GPA is figured.
3. The +, -, NC numbers following (where applicable) compare this quarter's GPA to last quarter. (+ = how much better, - = how worse, NC = no change from last quarter.)
4. The icon graphically represents an Instructor's performance (0-.75 Boom!; 76-1.5 Bird; 1.6-2.5 Scale; 2.6-3.5 Girl; 3.6-4.0 Beer).
5. A Bullet (•) with an Instructor's name means we could not confirm their teaching this class based on course listings available to the public.
6. Comments are excerpts from comments given by our interviewees and do not necessarily reflect those of the publishers, etc.

# Come 'on Guys, Pick Up the Tab

The Student Senate arm of the Student Government Association recently passed a resolution requesting that the University of Tennessee at Knoxville find alternative funding for the men's and women's athletic programs. The purpose of this consolidation was that the student activity fee be relieved of a 1.3 million dollar burden which currently funds 80% of the women's athletic program. University officials responded in characteristic fashion, flatly refusing the request. Chancellor Reese has defended the bifurcated funding

scheme, saying that it is more honest than channeling activity fees through a general athletic fund. Perhaps. He also said that the men's program could not afford the additional expense without a contribution from the activities fee. To that I say: Prove it!

On the honesty of the current system: There is a gloss of reason electroplated to this argument. However, to the cynic, other, less noble justifications spring to mind. Women's athletics, by law, must be funded. "No person in the United States shall, on the basis of sex, be excluded from participation in, be denied the benefits of, or be subjugated to discrimination under any education program or activity receiving Federal financial assistance..." [20 USCA sec. 1681 (a), Pub. L 92-318, Title IX sec. 901, June 23, 1972]. Any time a student or student group takes exemption to using the activity fee for this purpose and says "Oi!", Chancellor Reese and the Vice-Henchman Scheurer can, with beatific smiles, point to Title IX. "Oh, we must fund the women's programs. The law requires it!" Thus, the argument that the activity fee should not fund inter-collegiate athletics at all is sidetracked into a morass of gender discrimination, pious posing and hypocritical horseshit.

A second, even less charitable reason comes to mind. Suppose that UT was sued for a Title IX violation relating to women's

athletics. Under the current system, it would be more difficult to subpoena financial records of the men's athletic program. If the programs were centrally funded, all of the records would be fair game. This is not to allege any improprieties in the current funding. However, such improprieties, if they existed, could include persuading donors to give to the athletic program rather than to educational programs. This would violate the settlement order which ended a suit over funding the new arena. Of course, it would be the height of bad taste to suggest that there are any improprieties occurring anywhere within UTK, so we do not.



Hilton for "our boys" to live in, it can propose building a football complex of gargantuan proportions. But maybe 1.3 million is a little steep. O.K., Jack, how much do you have? If we consolidate the funding, you can pick up part of the tab, can't you?

You're not trying to say you're flat broke, strapped, (chuckle) out-of-pocket, (giggle) down to your last thin dime (gales of derisive laughter)? We don't believe you, Johnny-boy. If you can't pay for it all, you can at least pay for part.

What the current system does is allow a bloated, overfed athletic department to spend wildly in an era of multimillion dollar revenues and still charge students with an athletic fee. The uproar would be horrendous if the activity fee was raised at the same time that the gorged giant was spewing its excess over the playing fields. But by not centrally funding all the athletics, Jack & Co. relieve themselves of a burden and place it on the students. Men's athletics pay for itself. Traditionally, it also pays for women's athletics. Hey guys, be gentlemen, pick up the tab.

## Men's Athletics: Who's Passing the Buck

The men's athletic program is a financially separate arm of the University, receiving revenue from ticket sales, promotional licenses, advertising from radio and television game broadcasts, skybox rental, and from the students through the activities fee. It is a very large business to the tune of millions of dollars, and yet none of the revenue they create is redistributed back to the rest of the university.

Every other department of the University must produce a yearly budget requesting amounts used to pay faculty salaries, materials and maintenance. Any monies which are budgeted, but are not used are placed back in the "general fund" to be redistributed to departments which have minor budget overruns. No money can be saved year to year, and in this way, major purchases of expensive equipment and/or special programs must be allocated through budgeting procedures which are set up by state law. It is designed this way to consoli-

date budgetary authority in committee rather than give one person the authority to spend large amounts of money. When this works properly, with educated and informed committee members, it protects the public interests from possibly unbeneficial private and self-serving interests.

The men's athletic program exists under a separate governing body and is seemingly independent from regular budgetary procedure. Millions of dollars are generated but they disappear in a black hole of football related spending. Where exactly the money goes seems a very well guarded secret

to those who have attempted to find out how that money is spent, but some of the more obvious expenditures, such as the new Thompson/Boling Arena, renovations to Gibbs Hall, the construction of skyboxes, and the proposal

of an indoor football practice complex and a parking garage for season ticket holders, seem to illustrate the massiveness of this bloated cul de sac of revenue.

Who makes the decision to spend

ten of millions of dollars for the construction of buildings for the primary purpose of athletics? Why is a parking garage suddenly a viable option when students have been hearing for years, as they line up to buy ever more expensive parking stickers, that a parking garage would not be financially feasible? When the good of one department becomes more important than the good of the university community as a whole, I say private interests have become paramount and, for a public institution, it is scandalous.

It has often seemed that administrators feel that if the men's athletic program creates revenue, it is fair and just that they use the funds to serve their own interests, to promote and better their program. When the amounts become so sizable and the rest of the university community is suffering, in a sense picking up the tab with every fee increase, I feel it is time for athletics to pay for their right to be associated with this institution. Being the University of Tennessee Football Team is a franchise that should not be given away for free. Those that have

built the athletics program into the business success it is today should be commended, but they should not be allowed to hide behind the facade of a state university when they will not benefit the institution they parasite off of.

Every time you see a Vol™ logo, think of who is really benefiting when you show your school spirit.

At every game you attend, imagine the money filling the drawers of the box office and wonder why your activities fees are increasing. With all the talk of building a better university, it seems to me ironic that students are asked to make donations to support underbudgeted non-athletic departments, such as the library which, even through having a beautiful new structure in which to reside, is understaffed and underfunded for acquisitions. Perhaps the University of Tennessee will grow into a fine educational institution one day instead of remaining a glorified regional party college. Until that time, one can only hope that the disservice done to students of this school will become publicly recognized, for that is the first step towards change.

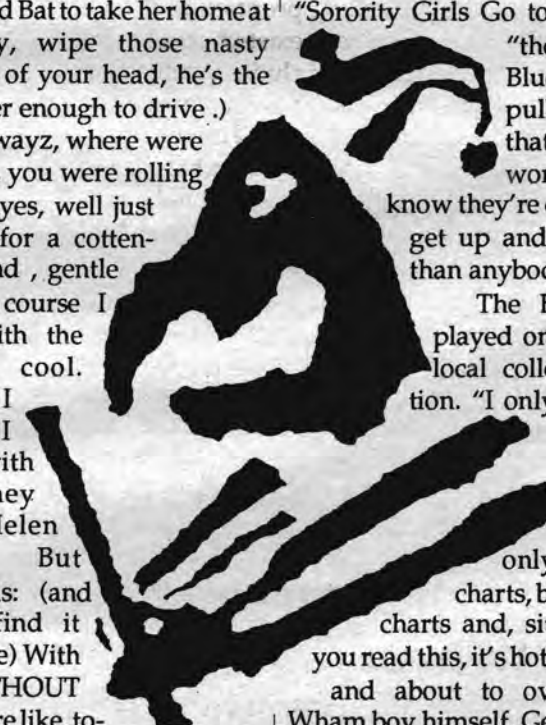

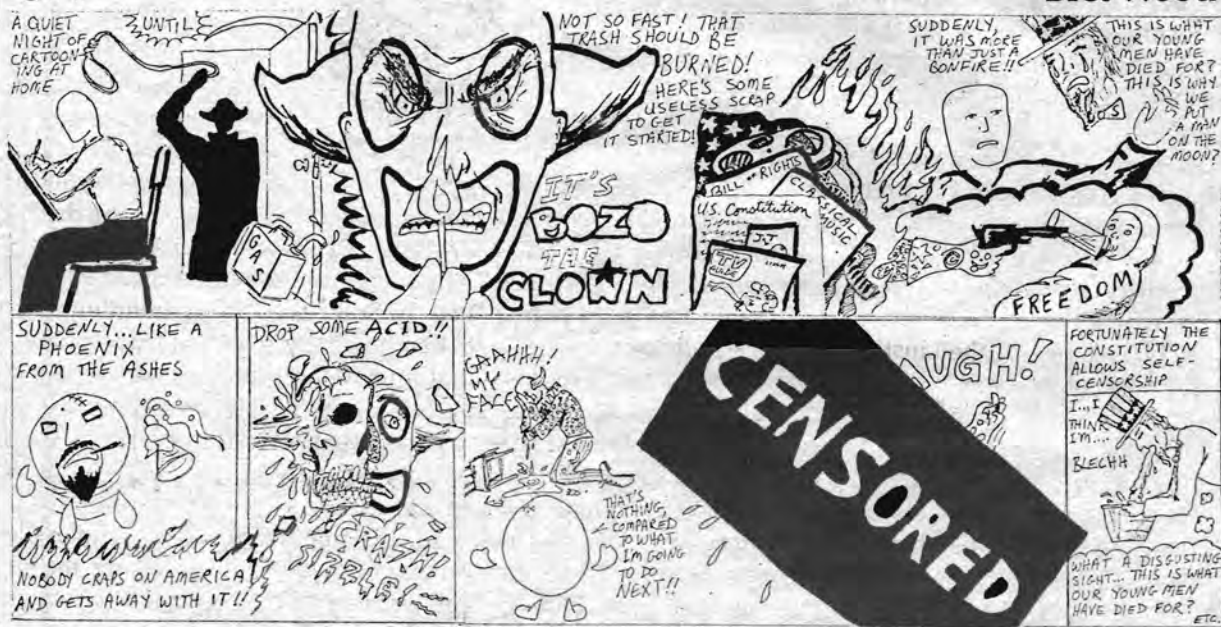
