# 'Lame Monkey' hits

## New tabloid satirizes life at UT, rates instruct

As Christopher Gray handed out copies of "The Lame Monkey Manifesto" to University of Tennessee students at registration, one student asked, "Is it Baptist or Communist?"

In his best pseudo-Southern accent, Gray replied, "Well, ma'am, it's neither. We let you make up your own mind."

So Gray and his co-editor friend Paul Mazingo are waiting for UT students, faculty and administrators to judge and respond to their satirical, off-beat, sometimes off-color portrait of the foibles and quirks of campus life.

"It's an issues paper, a comedy paper, a student-voice paper," said Mazingo, a fourth-year English major, of the 12-page tabloid that premiered this week. "It's not a newspaper in the least."

"Some of it's off-color, some of it's crude, some of it's offensive, but that's part of it," he said.

"A lot of that we try to do on purpose to stir things up, have people write in ... get UT students off their butt doing something."

"Ninety-nine percent of the people go to class, go out and get a beer on Friday night, and go home again," said Gray. "Our main purpose was to try to break through the apathy."

The paper opens with the face of a monkey peering through a page of type consisting just of variations of the word

phy, theater and television.

"We're the casual observers," Gray said, trying to describe themselves. In high school, "neither of us were football players or cheerleaders, their fans, preppies or intellectuals."

They fronted the money (less than \$300 for the printing and a few supplies) for the first issue, and each lost about \$100. They bartered ads for typesetting space and equipment at Universal Printing, and got two paid ads.

"We can't afford to put \$100 into it each time," meaning ads are critical if more issues are forthcoming, Mazingo said.

Also important are contributions of columns and art from more people — students, faculty, administrators or interested people.

"We're not anti-administration," said Mazingo. "We'd love to have the faculty," administrators and staff contribute, he said.

"We'd love to see it weekly or biweekly, but that's a pipe dream," said Gray.

"As a general rule, unless they're tightly organized and have a serious, permanent staff, the tabloid has been they tend to come and go depending on the interest of one or two students," said Le

We feel that this survey is useful not because of its flawless precision, but because it's the only information of its kind available to students. If you would like it to be more reliable—help out, give us a call.

We admire other third party attempts towards a more complete instructor evaluation process, but even the SGA's five-question form still leaves much to be desired. Hopefully in the future, the SGA will become a strong enough force to responsibly and impartially publish frank and useful information regarding the university, its faculty, and the teaching environment. #### How To Use This Information:

1. The first number next to the Instructor's name is the total number of responses we had regarding that prof. Remember, the fewer people surveyed, the more unreliable his/her evaluation.

2. The next number is the Grade Point Average of the Instructor. The Instructors were graded on a scale of A-F, where 'A' is 4 and 'F' is 0. The total number of these 'quality points' is divided by the total number of responses, much like the way your own GPA is figured.

3. The icon graphically represents an Instructor's performance (0-.75 Boom!; .76-1.5 Bird; 1.6-2.5 Scale; 2.6-3.5 Sex; 3.6-4.0 Beer).

4. A Bullet (•) after an Instructor's name means we could not confirm their teaching this class based on course listings available to Monkey™ Eval Staff.

**In Defense of Hyperbole**

Perhaps the most controversial feature of the Lame Monkey is the Instructor Evaluations. The attendant furor has yet to equal that of some of the religious debates from previous issues, however, some reactions to the Evaluations hint at great displeasure. Is the publication of these caustic, hateful attacks necessary, and can anything constructive be gleaned from material which is so seemingly destructive? In order to gain a more positive view, one should look beyond any insulting and degrading language found in the reviews.

Academic tenure creates a privileged class who enjoy a job security greater than that of incumbent members of Congress. A professor cannot be voted out, impeached or even fired for perpetrating any act short of an infamous crime. No other public employee could long afford to exhibit the outrageous behavior which is described in the Instructor Evaluations. The taxpayers would demand retribution. how might the student, who quite often is made to feel like a superfluous component of a University, respond to adverse treatment from the occasional misanthrope who is benefitted by such immunity?

A simple method of response is to submit an unkindly phrased review to the Instructor Evaluations. Don't expect the local constabulary to suddenly find numerous suicides with crumbled copes of the Lame Monkey Instructor Evaluations nearby. That is not the intent. These scathing commentaries are rather a catharsis for those who write them. A violent verbal assault (submitted anonymously, of course) is preferable to physical attack. The Instructor Evaluations also serve as a means of communication. Students can perhaps pay heed and avoid classes taught by those who consistently receive poor appraisals of either their teaching abilities or personalities.

It has been charged that the Instructor Evaluations are "unscientific" because they are not conducted according to accepted procedures for gathering statistics. So what? The evaluations must be regarded as expressions of opinion. Must these opinions be expressed by use of such vexatious means? Perhaps not, but critics of art, theatre, motion pictures and literature, as well as other human endeavors, make use of ridicule, satire, and humor to lend piquancy to their remarks. Robert L. Spellman, in an article entitled "The Critic's delight: Constitutional Protection for Criticism" which appeared in the Winter 1987 issue of the Journal of Popular Culture, demonstrates that biting,

harsh language is accepted and even expected as an element of critical opinion. One can argue that if a faculty member is to be verbally keelhailed, it ought to be based on their professional efforts and not vagaries of personality. Most students have neither the time, nor inclination to assess any scholarly material which has been produced by the object of their wrath. A student's opinion of an instructor can be based exclusively upon a positive or negative experience in the classroom. Many



other professions whose members are subject to public scrutiny are not kept immune to criticism. An educator should be no different.

Precisely because the Instructor Evaluation are not "scientific," a certain amount of error will always be present. Some of

the reviews can be dismissed as the products of grumblers and malcontents. A poor performance in a class cannot always be blamed upon the professor. It is interesting to note that the names of a few faculty members appear in a negative context on more than one occasion. Therefore, one must assume that these disparaging assertions have some basis in fact.

Seen within a broader context, the Instructor Evaluations serve a better purpose than mere insult. They are the efforts of students to counter the excesses of a few individuals who have conveniently forgotten that their salaries and benefits come from the taxpayers. There can be no damage caused by the free exchange of opinion even if this opinion is expressed in terminology which some believe to be unsavory.

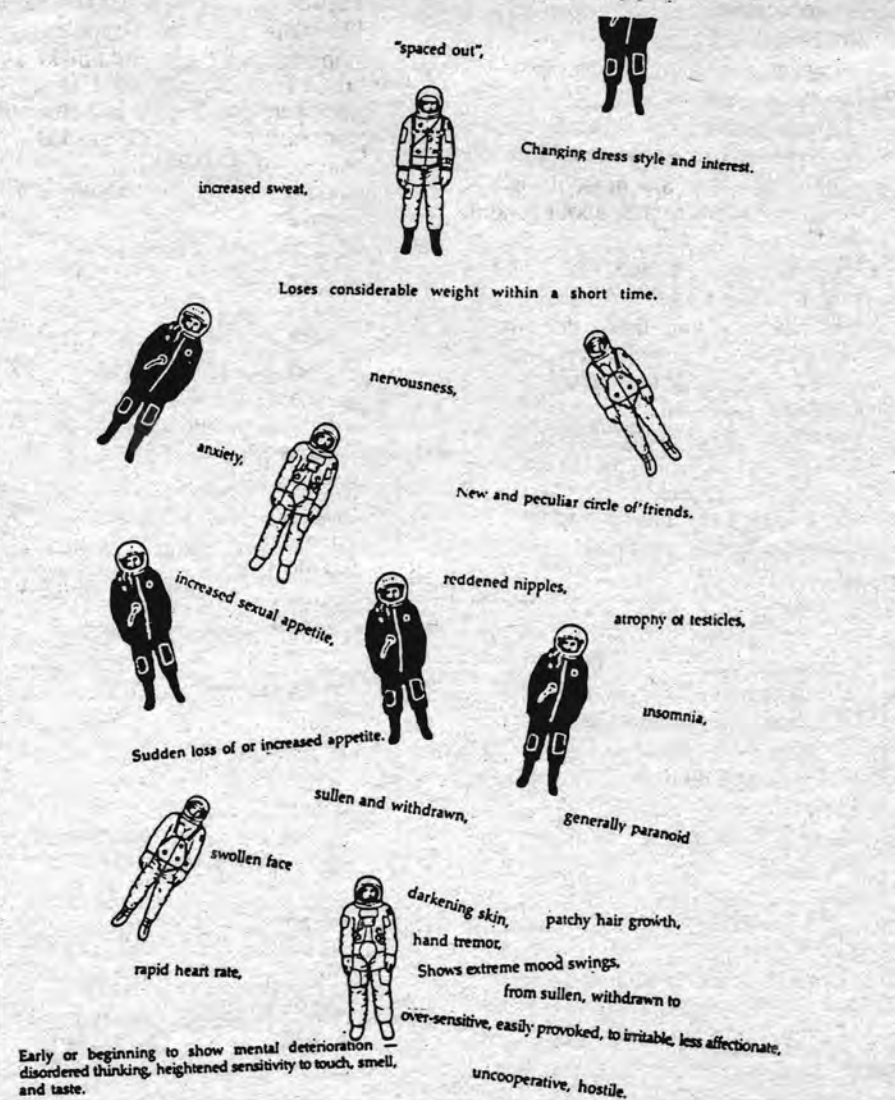

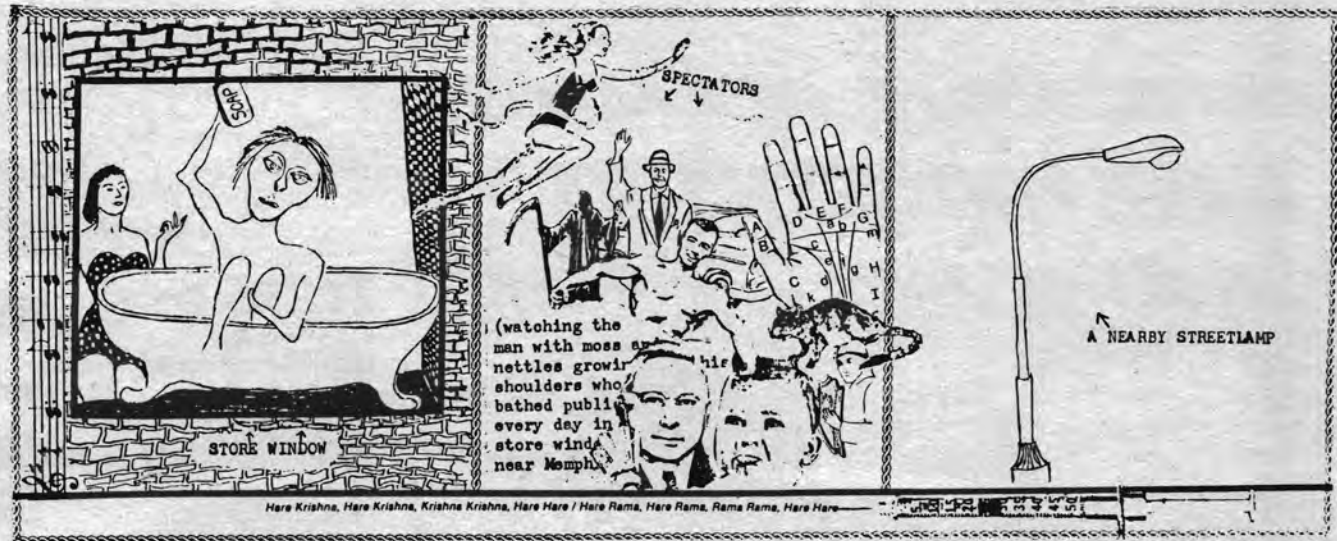
